General School Information

Mission

History of Fenton Community High School District 100

Before 1917, any high school education that was offered by the community was a part of the elementary school program. In 1917 Bensenville Elementary School District 2 began operating a two-year high school program which was expanded to a three-year program in 1920. The total enrollment in the three-year high school was 28 pupils. Frederick C. Fenton, for whom the present school is named, was employed in 1921 as the first school superintendent.

Community High School District 100, serving Bensenville and Wood Dale with a four-year program was formed in 1925 under a separate board of education--80 pupils were enrolled. These classes occupied the second floor of the Green Street School. When the new Bensenville Community High School was completed in April, 1927, about 110 high school students and eight teachers, as well as seventh and eighth grade classes, moved into the new structure.

Upon the death of Frederick C. Fenton in 1943, Wesley A. Johnson, then principal of the high school, was made Superintendent of District 100.

By 1951, enrollments had swelled to 442, a number which was greatly beyond the reasonable capacity of the building. A steel building to provide three supplementary classrooms was erected that year. Because of the crowded conditions, a citizen's committee was formed; and after extensive study, the committee recommended to the voters of the district that they approve the purchase of a new site and the construction of a new, modern high school building. The successful referendum enabled the Board of Education to purchase a 40-acre site and construct a new plant. Six hundred thirty-seven (637) students and 33 teachers moved into the new structure in September, 1955.

In September, 1961, a large addition to the building was completed increasing the overall capacity considerably. A continuing increase in growth necessitated further expansion, and in the fall of 1974 work was begun on several new additions. These additions included an auditorium, gymnasium, industrial arts shops, library, guidance center, and many new classrooms; work was completed in the summer of 1976.

Superintendent Johnson retired from his position in June, 1964, after many years of effective leadership in education in the communities. The former assistant superintendent and high school principal, Dr. Martin Zuckerman, was appointed to the position and served until June, 1971. Dr. James R. Coad was selected to serve as Superintendent of School District 2 and 100 from July, 1971 to June, 1983. The two districts voted to split and establish separate administrations in 1983. Dr. Coad remained with District 2 until his retirement in 1988, and Mr. Carl D. Herren, the former principal at Fenton, was named as Superintendent on July 1, 1983. Mr. Herren served as Superintendent until his retirement in August, 1992; that same month Dr. John G. Meredith of Hudson, Michigan was hired as the new Superintendent.

In June of 2000, Dr. Meredith retired and Dr. Alf Logan was named as Superintendent. Prior to being appointed Superintendent, Dr. Logan served as Fenton's principal for 17 years. Mrs. Kathie Pierce was then appointed as Fenton's first female Principal to replace Dr. Logan. Both assumed their positions on July 1, 2000. On July 1, 2007, Dr. Logan retired and Mrs. Pierce replaced him as Superintendent. Mr. Todd Leden, formerly Assistant Principal and Athletic Director, replaced Mrs. Pierce as Principal.


