- Mr. George's Report –
- **Did you know...** **Students with high levels of arts participation outperform "arts-poor" students on virtually every measure.** Based on an analysis of the Department of Education's data base of 25,000 students, UCLA Graduate School of Education & Information Studies Professor James S. Catterall found that sustained involvement in the arts correlates with success in other subjects, and in developing positive attitudes about community - both generally and also for children in poverty. The correlation is particularly strong between music and success in math.
- Students have a practice schedule (copy attached). They also have a concert and take home folder. The band room is available before and after school, also during lunch and study hall. Section leaders can schedule a morning practice.

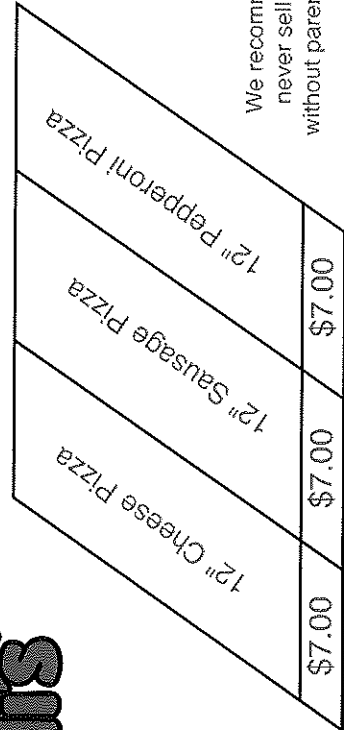
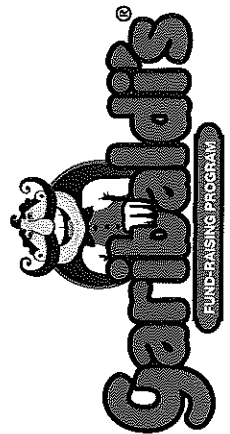
