ENROLLMENT INFORMATION:

Registration is filled on a first come first serve basis. PUPS is designed for children ages six weeks to five years. The maximum number of children is 30 per day. The program runs from beginning of October through the middle of May. The fee is \$60 per family per year, regardless of the number of children they enroll in the program.

The Fenton High School PUPS Program (Parents Utilizing Pre-School Skills) not only provides benefits to Fenton students, but also for the children and families in the community and their parents. This unique child development program incorporates a learning environment for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers, a teaching experience for Fenton students, and a networking time for the parents of the children in the class.

The program is supervised by teachers from the Fenton Family and Consumer Sciences Department, the class is actually run by Fenton students who act as teachers for the children. Each child enrolled in the program is paired with one to two high school students, allowing for individualized attention and age-appropriate activities for each child. Please note, parents of children ages 0-2 must remain at Fenton during the duration of PUPS.
